

PATRICK GARBIN is a freelance journalist who has been recognized as an authority and historian of college football and “the foremost historian of Georgia Bulldogs football.” He has written nine traditionally-published books, seven of which are on University of Georgia football, and has been a consultant and researcher for several other book projects.

Currently, Patrick is the Beat Reporter for *DAWGTIME Magazine* and DawgTime.com. He is also a contributing writer and the social media administrator for *BAMATIME* (Alabama football) and *TIGERTIME* (Clemson football). In addition, Patrick is a Contributor to UGASports.com of the Rivals Network, and maintains the *About Them Dawgs! Blawg*—the only website primarily dedicated to the history and tradition of UGA’s football program.

Patrick has made numerous public appearances, speaking to groups primarily on the topics of college football and the book publishing industry. He also has participated in dozens of book signings, been featured in radio and television interviews, and has conducted hundreds of player and coach interviews for his books, blog, articles, and other work. In addition, because of Patrick’s persistent efforts, the UGA athletic department reestablished the *Hugh Hendrix Memorial Award* beginning in 2014 after the honor had been mistakenly discontinued by the UGA football program for more than 20 years.
